Requirements: Namibian citizen or permanent resident; science background with a minimum of a Bachelor’s degree preferably a masters degree in Natural Resource Management, Biodiversity Management of Fisheries; minimum 6 months of work experience of internships; high interest in Nature Conservation and people’s livelihoods and in working for an NGO; excellent command in English as well as writing and reporting skills; enthusiasm for fieldwork; due to the project being in the Zambezi region a working knowledge of Rugkwangali or Silozi will be an added advantage; driver’s license is non-negotiable.

Your application must be addressed to Jessica@nnf.org.na and submitted no later than 17:00 on Monday the 27th of September.

You must title your email in the subject line – Project Trainee 2021

Your application should consist of a motivation letter of no more than 2 pages outlining why you are the person for the job and also contain a concise CV.
