Requirements: Namibian citizen or permanent resident; a diploma or a degree in Natural Resource Management, Biodiversity Management or Fisheries or 5 years of adequate demonstrated work experience in a relevant field with references; minimum 3 years of work experience; high interest in Nature Conservation and people’s livelihoods and in working for an NGO; excellent command in English as well as writing and reporting skills; enthusiasm for fieldwork (including camping) and working with communities; due to the project being in the Zambezi region a working knowledge of Silozi will be an added advantage; driver’s license is non-negotiable.

Your application must be addressed to jessica@nnf.org.na and submitted no later than 17:00 on Monday the 27th of September.

You must title your email in the subject line – Fisheries Development Officer 2021

Your application should consist of a motivation letter of no more than 2 pages outlining why you are the person for the job and also contain a concise CV.

Other documents may be requested at the shortlisting stage. Please note that due to the high number of applications, only shortlisted candidates will be contacted.
